Lifelong Learning: A Commitment To OT Continued Competency

Providing Direction: OT Regulations and Standards

CBOT. Continued competency regulations require occupational therapy practitioners to complete 24 professional development units (PDUs) every two years as a condition of license renewal. (CA Code of Regulations, Title 16, Division 39, Article 7, Section 4161)

ACOTE. Standard B.7.0, Professional Ethics, Values, and Responsibilities includes 'commit to engaging in lifelong learning.'

Leading the Way: 5 Components of OTAC's Commitment to Lifelong Learning

1. OTAC Code of Ethics—Education Principle

Engage in lifelong professional learning to stay current and ensure competency in practice as well as actively participating in the growth of the profession

2. OTAC Core Values—Education Principle

Professional Development to provide quality education and resources to advance the knowledge, skills, and continued competence of occupational therapy practitioners.

3. OTAC Professional Development and Leadership Committee

Purpose: This committee provides leadership, coordination, and support for continuing education of occupational therapy practitioners throughout the state. Email: educchr@otaconline.org

4. OTAC Peer-Reviewed Professional Development

OTAC Annual Conference and the Western Regional Occupational Therapy Symposium (WROTSS) sessions are peer-reviewed by up to three practitioners with expertise in any given practice area.

5. OTAC MyOTLicense—Tracking PDUs

MyOTLicense is a cloud-based 'filing cabinet' allowing practitioners to store all information required by CBOT for licensure renewal, with 24/7/365 accessibility. Never misplace a certificate of completion.
